### Winter at the Seashore

Recent experience suggests that flying north for brunch in the wintertime is a dubious proposition. Though we don't usually think of going to the seashore in winter, it's an area that's likely to be relatively snow-free. So we're going to Ocean City, NJ.

From its "official" founding in 1879 as a community by four Methodist ministers, Ocean City has maintained its character as a friendly, family-oriented resort. In keeping with its origins, the city has banned the sale of alcoholic beverages, and recently voted not to allow bring-your-own-bottles in restaurants. A significant historical event, commemorated by the names of restaurants and a boardwalk rest pavilion, was the 1901 sinking of the *Sindia*, a steel-hulled, four-masted bark. For many years, the wreckage was visible just a couple of hundred yards offshore, and was salvaged extensively for its cargo of porcelain and silks from China and Japan. No remnants of the wreck are visible now.

Ocean City Municipal Airport (26N), with its permanent, built-in crosswind, is our February 22 flyout destination for breakfast or lunch at the Airport Diner in the FBO building. It's frequented by both locals and incoming pilots. There's no landing fee so long as you don't leave the airport, but they will charge you if you walk out on the "land side." Straight line,

it's a 73 nm flight. With proper procedures (be certain you hear the words "cleared into the Class B") and a little bit of luck, Philly approach control will let you go direct, giving you and your guests a tour of downtown and a bird's-eye view of Philadelphia International. Otherwise, duck under the Class B airspace to the south, and head over south Jersey.

We'll gather at Penn Airways at 1000 for 1030 takeoff. Bring a friend or bring a student pilot (or bring a friend who is a student pilot). Contact Gene Poppel at 610-647-1332 or [genepoppel@comcast.net](mailto:genepoppel@comcast.net) if you want a ride or have an available seat in your plane.

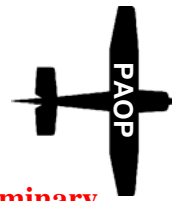
