Late Summer at the Seashore

From its "official" founding in 1879 as a community by four Methodist ministers, Ocean City, NJ has maintained its character as a friendly, family-oriented resort. In keeping with its origins, the city has banned the sale of alcoholic beverages, and even this year voted not to allow bring-your-own-bottles in restaurants. One of the significant events, commemorated by the names of restaurants and a boardwalk rest pavilion, was the 1901 sinking of the *Sindia*, a steel-hulled, four-masted bark. For many years, the wreckage was visible just a couple of hundred yards offshore, and was salvaged extensively for its cargo of porcelain and silks from China and Japan. No remnants of the wreck are visible now.

Ocean City Municipal Airport (26N), with its permanent, built-in crosswind serves the city, and is a popular pilot destination. A short walk takes you to a small nature preserve and the beach. The restrooms are suitable for changing into your beach attire. There's even a small golf course adjacent to the airport.

Ocean City is our September 30 flyout destination, heading for breakfast or lunch at

the Airport Diner in the FBO building. It's frequented by both locals and incoming pilots. There's no landing fee so long as you don't leave the airport, but they will charge you if you walk out on the "land side." Straight line, it's a 73 nm flight. With proper procedures (be certain you hear the words "cleared into the Class B") and a little bit of luck, Philly approach control will let you go direct, giving you and your guests a tour of downtown and a bird's-eye view of Philadelphia International. Otherwise, duck under the Class B airspace to the south, and head over south Jersey.

We'll gather at Penn Airways at 1000 for 1030 takeoff. Bring a friend or bring a student pilot (or bring a friend who is a student pilot). Contact Gene Poppel at 610-647-1332 or genepoppel@comcast.net if you want a ride or have an available seat in your plane. These flights can be used to give student pilots a chance to plan and follow a cross-country flight, without having to simultaneously fly the plane—a good step in their training.
