A bonus will be a good look at the start of nature's display of fall colors on the nearby mountainsides.

On September 29 we will fly to the Luray airport for a day of exploration. There's a new identifier—KLUA; in case you haven't updated your GPS lately, the old one was W45. There's a one-hour tour of the cave that takes a little over an hour and included admission to the Car and Carriage Caravan Museum. Don't forget warm clothing, as the interior of the cave is at a constant 54 damp, chilly degrees. Wear old shoes, because those mineral drips can be hard to remove. A casual restaurant is on the

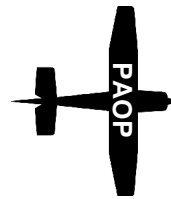

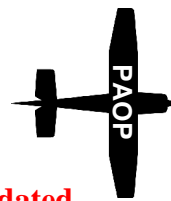
